

1. Overview

The Jurisprudence Directory provides a directory of all WTO reports, awards and decisions that have been circulated to the WTO Members and thereby made public. It also provides a directory of GATT 1947 and GATT Code jurisprudence.

2. WTO Jurisprudence Directory


The WTO jurisprudence directory provides instant access to the complete texts of WTO reports, awards and decisions along with summaries and a link to all of the procedural documents circulated in a dispute.

2.1. Full Texts

The texts in this directory are in their original format and are complete (in contrast to the optimized and redacted texts that are used in the integrated PDF browser in the research tools).

For each report, award and decision there is a concise research summary of the principal findings in the document along with a link to additional more detailed summaries.

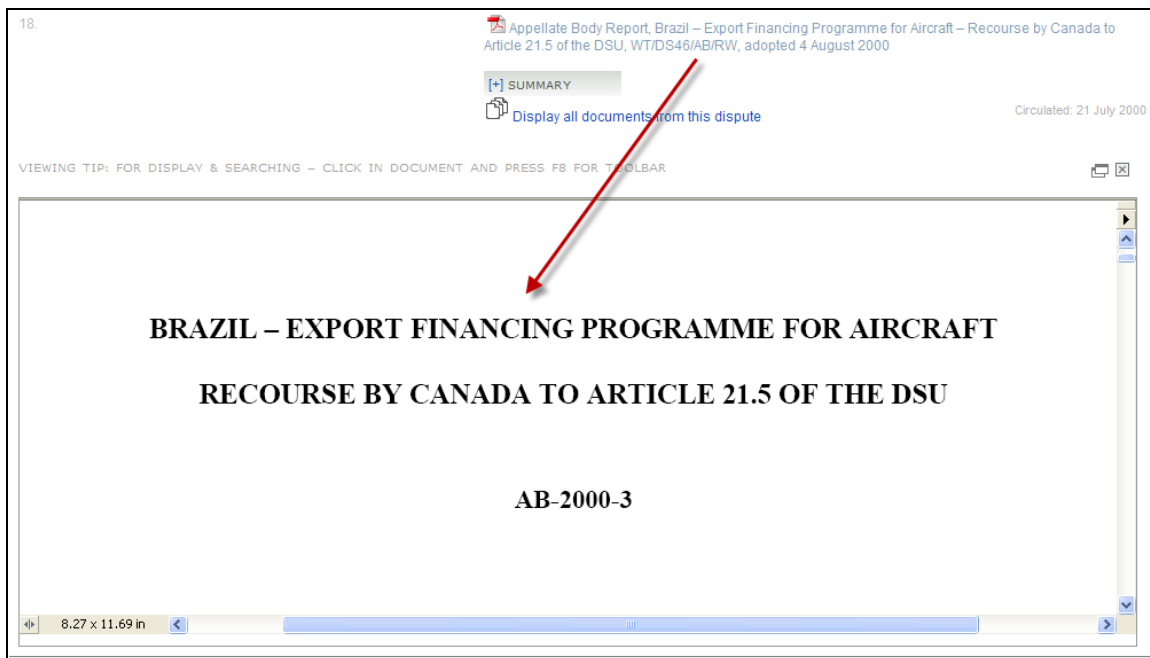
The Appellate Body upheld the Panel's finding that Brazil was continuing to make payments under a subsidy programme already found to involve prohibited export subsidies inconsistent with Article 3.1(a) of the SCM Agreement (paras. 39-47). The Appellate Body upheld the Panel's finding that payments made under the revised PROEX were not justified under item (k) of the Illustrative List of Export Subsidies in Annex I of the SCM Agreement, on the grounds that Brazil had failed to demonstrate that PROEX payments were not 'used to secure a material advantage in the field of export credit terms' within the meaning of the first paragraph of item (k) (paras. 48-80).

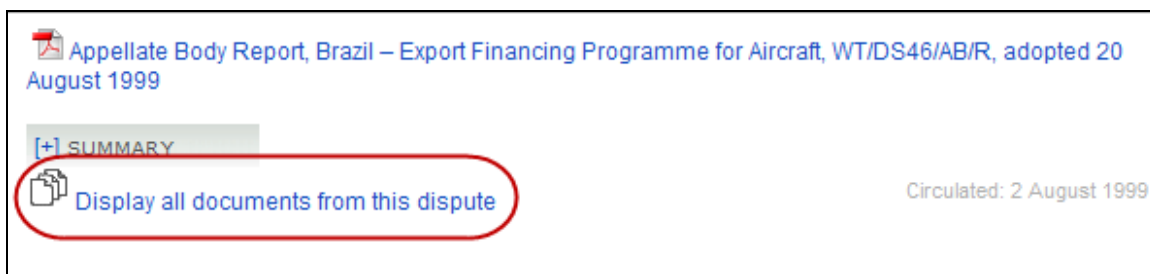


2.4. Quick Sort Options

You can quickly sort the directory by the principal types of jurisprudence by clicking on the relevant quick sort button.




2.5. Detailed Sort Options and Filters
